

Payment Policies

- A \$450 deposit is required **within ten days** of the student's application for registration.
- The balance of program costs for **England, France and Italy** is due by **April 15, 2008**.
- The balance of program costs for **Canada and Mexico** is due by **May 15, 2008**.
- All deposits and payments must be submitted to the Student Cashier's Office, Coronna Hall, 1st Floor, P.O. Box 44444, Lafayette, LA 70504, (337) 482-6385.
- Current UL Lafayette students: The cost of the program is charged to your student account and you will have holds placed on your registration for any unpaid balances.
- In the event of an unexpected change in currency exchange rates, and prior to May 1, 2008, an exchange rate surcharge may be necessary.
- Non-UL Lafayette students will be sent a separate information packet and payment schedule.
- Non-UL Lafayette students must apply for admission to the University.

Refund Policy

- This special program does **not** operate under the standard University of Louisiana at Lafayette refund policy.
- Early registration students for **England, France and Italy** withdrawing after **February 1** will forfeit a nonrefundable \$250.00 deposit. Students for **England, France and Italy** who register after February 1 and then withdraw will likewise lose the same \$250.00 deposit.
- Early registration students for **Canada and Mexico** withdrawing after **March 1** will forfeit a nonrefundable \$250.00 deposit. Students for **Canada and Mexico** who register after March 1 and then withdraw will likewise lose the same \$250.00 deposit.
- Other amounts may be lost depending on when the student withdraws if monies have been paid to host institutions, insurance companies, or for prepaid activities.
- **Students for England, France and Italy withdrawing after April 15 will owe a minimum of \$2,000.00 due to lost deposits and it will be charged to their UL Lafayette account.**
- **Students for Canada and Mexico withdrawing after May 15 will owe a minimum of \$2,000.00 due to lost deposits and it will be charged to their UL Lafayette account.**
- Once the program has left the United States, participants will receive **no refund**.
- If students find that for some reason they must drop out of the program, early notification to the Study Abroad Office will help insure the largest refund possible.

Cost and Expenses by Program

QUEBEC CITY, CANADA – July 6 – August 8, 2008

Program costs include: room and 2/3 board, tuition, insurance, museums, entrance fees, field trips, and public transportation passes. Airfare is not included and must be purchased by the student.

Registration **before** March 1, 2008: **\$3600.00**

Registration **after** March 1, 2008: **\$3700.00**

Registration Deadline: April 1, 2008

Costs **do not include** such items as: airfare to Canada, passport fees, ISIC card, laundry, telephone and internet costs, lodging while traveling, meals other than those specified, and items of a personal nature. We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation insurance in case of emergencies.

LONDON, ENGLAND – May 28 – June 11, 2008

Program costs include: bed and breakfast at a London hotel, tuition, insurance, museums, entrance fees, field trips, public transportation passes and complimentary wireless for student laptops. Airfare is not included and must be purchased by the student.

Registration **before** February 1, 2008: **\$3250.00**

Registration **after** February 1, 2008: **\$3350.00**

Registration Deadline: March 1, 2008

Costs **do not include** such items as: airfare to London, passport fees, ISIC card, laundry and telephone costs, public access to the internet, lodging while traveling, meals other than those specified, and items of a personal nature. We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation insurance in case of emergencies.

PARIS, FRANCE – May 30 – July 12, 2008

Program costs include: room and 2/3 board, tuition, insurance, museums, entrance fees, field trips, and public transportation passes. Airfare is not included and must be purchased by the student.

Registration **before** February 1, 2008: **\$5800.00**

Registration **after** February 1, 2008: **\$5900.00**

Registration Deadline: March 1, 2008

Costs **do not include** such items as: airfare to Paris, passport fees, ISIC card, Eurail pass, laundry, telephone and internet costs, lodging while traveling, meals other than those specified, and items of a personal nature. We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation insurance in case of emergencies.

FLORENCE, ITALY – May 28 – July 9, 2008

Program costs include: round-trip airfare, room, tuition, insurance, museums, entrance fees and field trips including Rome.

Registration **before** February 1, 2008: **\$6600.00**

Registration **after** February 1, 2008: **\$6700.00**

Registration Deadline: March 1, 2008

Costs **do not include** such items as: passport fees, ISIC card, Eurail pass, laundry, telephone and internet costs, lodging while traveling, meals, and items of a personal nature. **Students will be responsible for any additional government imposed taxes, security charges or fuel surcharges on the airline ticket, if imposed by the airlines.** Typically, this has rarely occurred but each person is liable for any increase.

MEXICO CITY, MEXICO – June 16 – July 7 (Lafayette), July 7 – July 28 (Mexico)

Program costs include: airfare, lodging, tuition and public transportation passes.

Registration **before** March 1, 2008: **\$ 3000.00**

Registration **after** March 1, 2008: **\$ 3100.00**

Registration Deadline: April 1, 2008

Costs **do not include** such items as: passport fees, ISIC card, laundry, telephone and internet costs, lodging while traveling, meals and items of a personal nature.
